Creeping red fescues are often slow to establish, especially compared to perennial ryegrass in bare soil. Heidrun breaks the mould here.

Heidrun performs better than many other creeping red fescue varieties in recent trials. Heidrun also performed better than others in repair and overseeding mixtures, making Heidrun the choice of many Greenkeepers.

Improved wear tolerance

Strong creeping red fescue has average wear tolerance, but through breeding improved performance is observed with Heidrun.

Very high shoot density

Red fescue is fine and dense - nevertheless we added a little more density. There are few chances for weeds to find room to establish.

Higher salt tolerance

In our salt tolerance trials Heidrun has shown performance above the average for the species.
